Student’s strength has also increased from 750 to 970 spreading from Pr KG to XII standard.

By providing a conducive and encouraging environment the students of BAPS are mentored to participate in a variety of intra and interschool competitions. The year 2018 – 19 saw a rich crop of trophies and shields being harvested by our students, in scholastic & co – scholastic activities.

Sri Sai foundation conducts state level talent exam for school students in which **S.DHARANEEDHARAN** of grade 5 secured 3rd places in the state level and in the district level **S.SANJAY** and **HARISHANKAR** of grade III has bagged II and III prizes respectively.

LEENA SRI & HEMA SRI of grade V & VIII were awarded Rs.20,000 by Coimbatore Science & Technology (CSTF) for their outstanding project presentation.

Our children's talents were acknowledged by Erode District Collector Mr.C.Kathiravan in "elam vingnani -2019" contest held at Nandha Engineering College. Two teams of baps bagged first & second prizes for their projects and were awarded a cash prize of Rs.1,500 & Rs.1000 respectively.

The Silver zone conducts Olympiad exam for grade I to XII in various subjects in their curriculum. 14 of our students have grabbed 24 medals comprising of Gold, Silver & Bronze in English, Mathematics, Science and General knowledge.

Students participated in the Annual cultural fiesta organized by Kongu Sahodaya Schools Complex with 125 CBSE schools as members at Nandha Engineering College, Erode. Our children won 5 best performance awards and prizes, out of the 8 items participated thus exposing their talents beyond the school premises.

Our girls Kabbadi team firmly tucked another resplendent feather in its illustrious cap. The team emerged proud winners of the KSSC Kabbadi match in Under 19 and Under 17 category by grabbing the gold medal.

Various house competitions were conducted with students from four different houses competing in a variety of off stage and stage items incorporating their creative talents.

Inorder to hone the understanding skills of the students in their curriculum; several scholastic activities were conducted by instructors from Bannari Amman Institute of Technology. We look forward for such helping hands from BIT in future, too.

Important days like independence day, children's day, Teachers' day and festivals like Diwali, Pongal and Christmas were celebrated in the school in due manner.

As part of study tour, students of class 6 and 7 had a 2 day trip to Bangalore. This was the first time an excursion was conducted for the 6th graders in BAPS. Students of 8, 9 and 11 also had a 2 day trip to Trivandrum.
